
²⁷ And God created man in His own image, in the image of God created Him; male and female God (our Triune God) created them.

Key Thoughts



God says **us** and **our** when He creates Adam and Eve in His divine image. This gives men and women equality and both share divine dignity. We are equal yet we have distinctives like the Trinity. We also share a delight together in one another.

Each Person of The Trinity is Devine:

The Trinity is one in essence...coequally and coeternally God." (Wycliffe Dictionary of Theology)

The Trinity is the Same Yet Distinct:

Each member has Their role – a harmony without hierarchy yet, there is submission in the Trinity and they defer to each other without losing their equality and their divine dignity.

The Trinity is Delight:

The Trinity delights in each other. There is no greater place of beauty and harmony, unity and order, and joy and delight in each other than the Trinity.
